


<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>In English, we will be basing our English work on the wonderful book 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl. It will begin with looking at different characters and writing a character description which will include ambitious vocabulary, expanded noun phrases and relative clauses. We will then move our focus onto adverbial phrases, conjunctions, the past progressive tense and direct speech to write our own escape scene. Finally, we will also be writing a newspaper report all about Mr Fox's escape which will include direct speech and the present perfect tense.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>In Maths we will be exploring our understanding of fractions. We will be exploring fractions of amounts and ordering and comparing fractions. We will develop our knowledge of fractions by making the whole and placing fractions on a number line. The children will also deepen their understanding of equivalent fractions by using fraction walls. Pupils will also be developing their understanding of mass and capacity. Children will explore different unit of measurements using pictorial representation and hands on activity.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>History / Geography</u></p> <p>Our Geography topic for this half term is Extreme Survival. We will be looking at a range of different extreme environments on Earth, including deserts, rainforests and the Polar Regions. We will discover how it is possible for humans and other lifeforms to survive in such harsh conditions and we will look closely at the lives of Bedouin people to deepen our understanding in this area. We will also explore animal and plant adaptations, natural disasters and how to look after our planet.
