Competition Codes of Conduct

Competitors

- Always do my best, even if I am losing or the other team is stronger
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- Never be rude to my team mates, the other team, the referees, spectators or my coach/team manager
- Do what the referee tells me
- Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
- Listen to my coach/team manager and listen to what he/she says

Spectators

- Remain outside the field of play and behind any designated spectator areas
- Never engage in or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Always respect the referees/officials decisions
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Remember that children play for FUN
- Let the coach do their job, don't confuse competitors by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition and match officials
- Never criticise a player for making a mistake. Mistakes are part of learning

Teachers & School Staff

- Show respect to others involved in the game including referees, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials and spectators
- Adhere to the Laws of the Game
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Always respect the match officials and referees decisions
- Never enter the field of play without the referee or match official's permission
- Never engage in public criticism of the referees or match officials
- Never engage in or tolerate, offensive, or abusive language or behaviour
