Dear Parents / Carers,

We are very excited to announce a new award initiative for our children: The Wylde Green Primary School Citizenship Award Scheme.

The purpose of the initiative is:

- To recognise and acknowledge the active role children play in the life of the school and the wider community
- To encourage children to make positive choices which will benefit their class, school and community
- To encourage children to become responsible, informed and active members of their class, school and wider community

The award is split into three levels – Bronze, Silver and Gold.

Bronze level	this focuses upon how to be an active member of their class community
Silver level	this encourages children to be a responsible member of their key stage or school
Gold level	this challenges our children to contribute towards their local community

The Bronze level award is commencing this January, with the Silver and Gold awards being launched later in the year. Your child will receive a booklet this week that outlines all of the challenges they should aim to achieve in order to receive their Bronze level. These challenges are age appropriate and differ for each year group. Further information can be found on the school's website under Community, WGPS Citizenship Award Scheme.

Children will be challenged to achieve their Bronze Award by the end of the summer term. In celebration of the achievements, we will hold a special assembly award where those pupils who have successfully completed their award will receive a special Bronze pin badge which can be worn on their uniform and a Bronze Award certificate. One child from each class will also be chosen for a prestigious Citizenship badge.

We would like to thank you in advance for your support in helping to make the WGPS Citizenship Award Scheme a success within school and for supporting your child to become a responsible citizen of the future.
