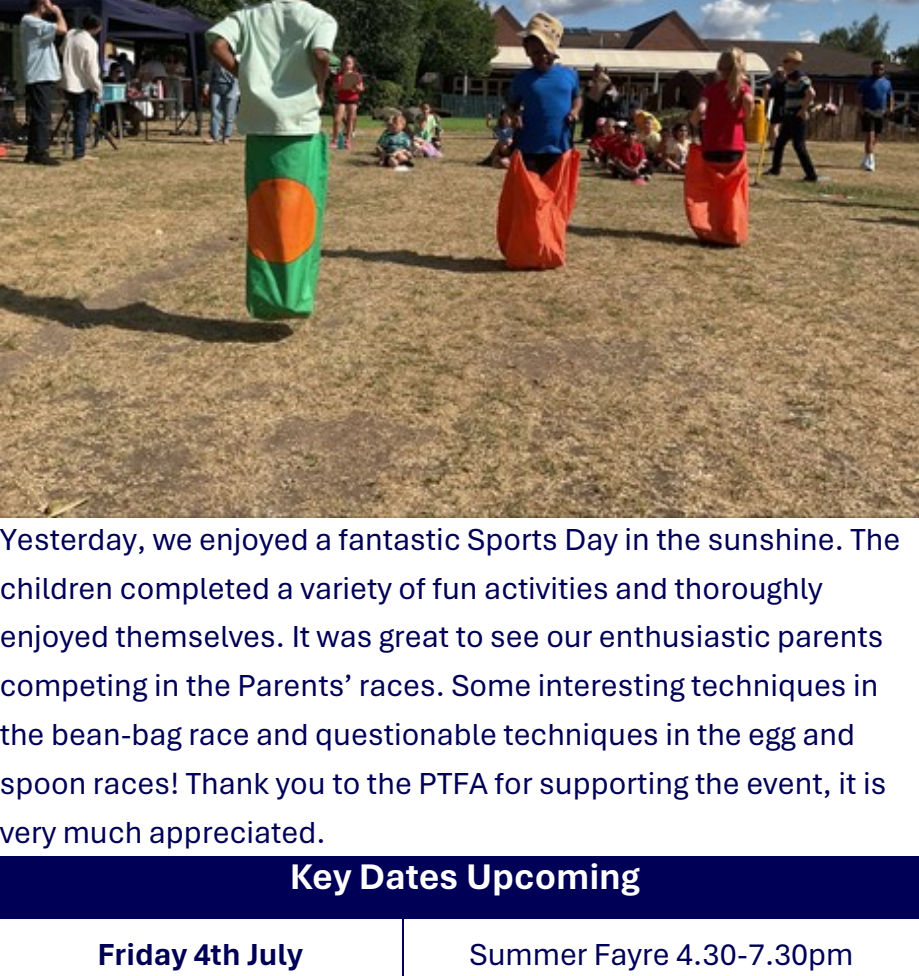


Sports Day

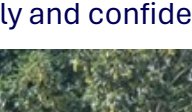

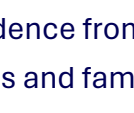

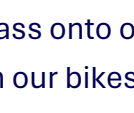
Performing in Assembly



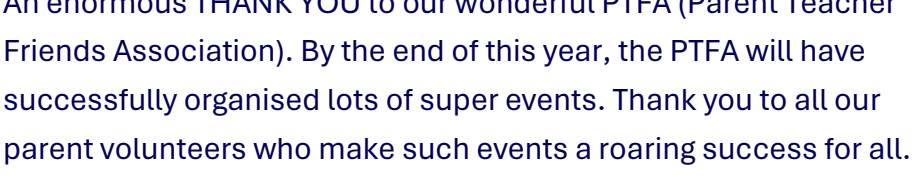

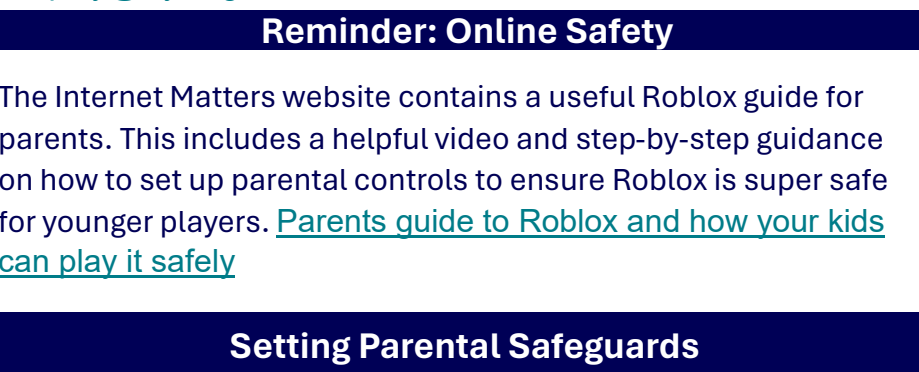
Twenty-five challenges, ten weeks, a world of books to explore.
