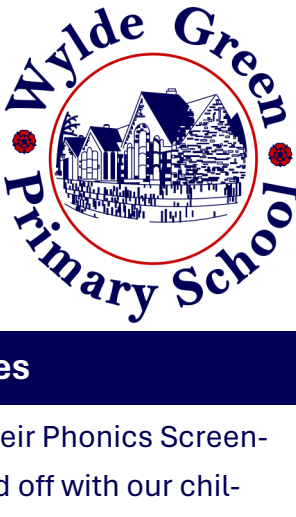

Assessments updates

Last week our children in **Year 1** completed their Phonics Screening Check. Lots of hard work and practice paid off with our children performing extremely well. This is a national test which all Year 1 pupils complete. The purpose of the phonics screening check is to confirm that all children have learned phonic decoding to an age appropriate standard. We do not yet know what the pass threshold is but in previous years, the threshold has been 32/40. School will be informed by the DfE in due course. We shall inform all parents of their child's result with their end of year school report.

Last week was the **Year 4** Multiplication Check which the whole year group completed. The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to x12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help us to identify if your child may need additional support. Your child's score will be shared with their end of year school report. There is no pass mark for the check.

This week our children in **Reception** have completed their Early Years Foundation stage final assessment, which summarizes their level of development against the Early Learning Goals. Reception parents will receive a written summary of your child's development within their end of year school report. This will include whether they have achieved the expected level of development (GLD) within the prime areas of Communication and Language; Physical Development; Literacy; Mathematics and Personal, Social and Emotional Development.

Transition Day

On Wednesday 2nd July, our Year 6 pupils will visit their new secondary schools in preparation for September. We wish them all the very best for their 'taster day'. Also on this day, the children in Reception to Year 5 will spend time with their new teachers for September. Reminder:

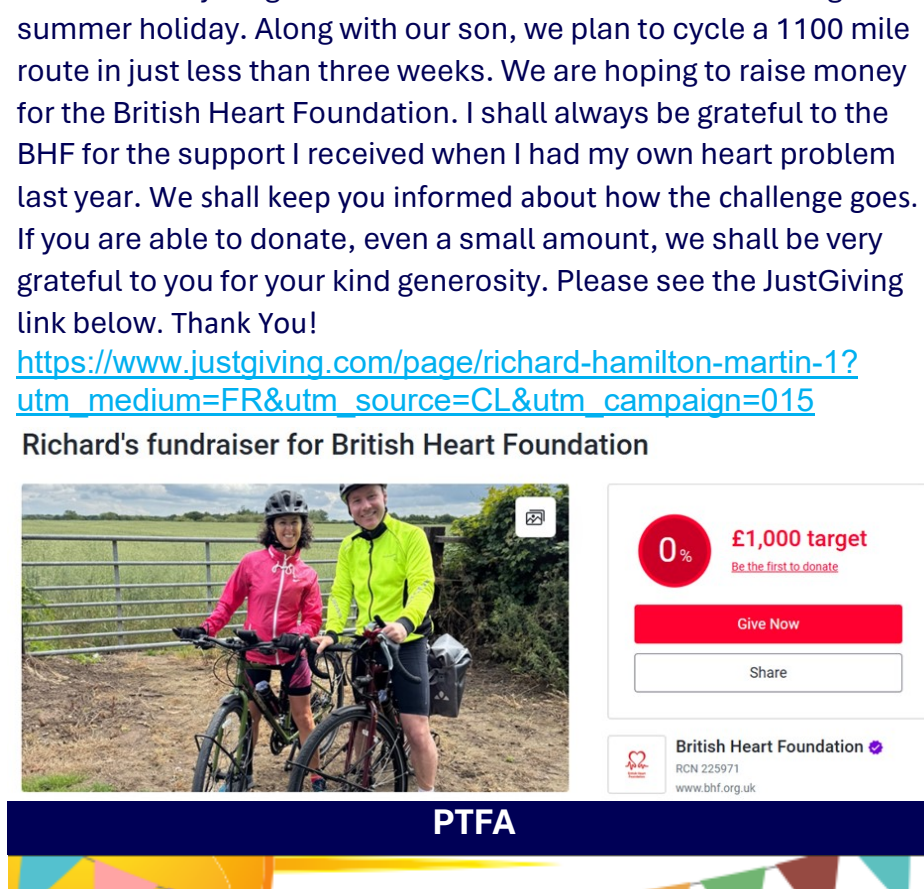
Please do not send packed lunches with any food which may contain nuts. We are a nut-free school and have children who have nut allergies.

People who suffer from nut allergies can develop a severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reaction. If someone has a nut allergy it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction, just being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nuts or a product containing nuts can trigger anaphylactic shock (which can cause breathing and swallowing difficulties).

We have some children in school who have nut allergies that require use of an Epi-pen if they come into contact with nuts.
