PTFA—Library Fundraising Update

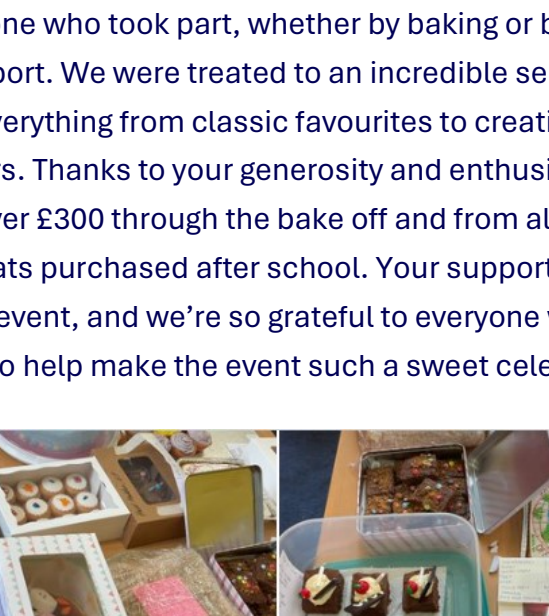

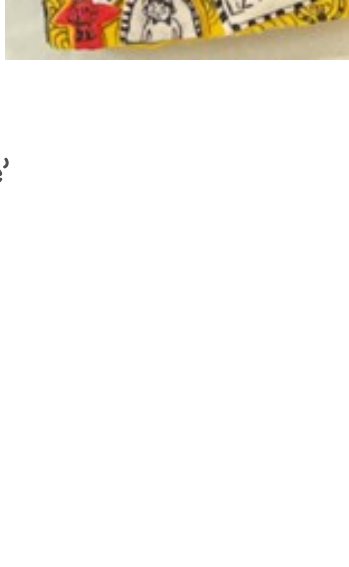

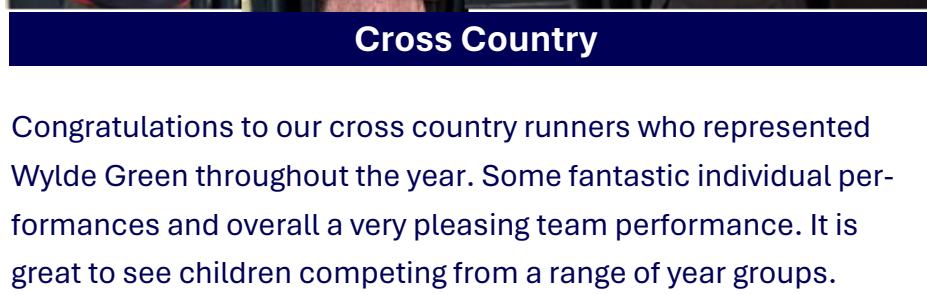

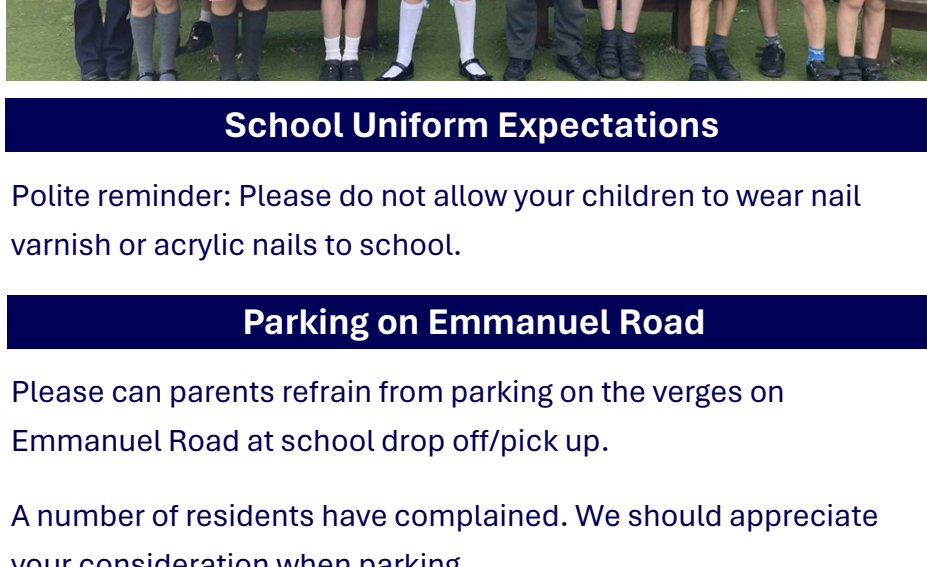
