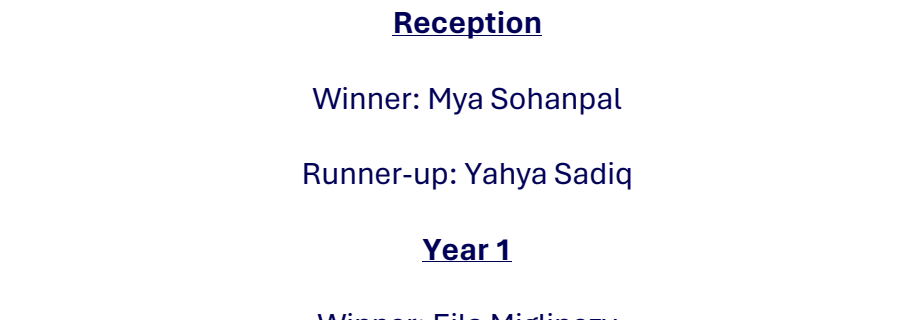
Year 6 SATs

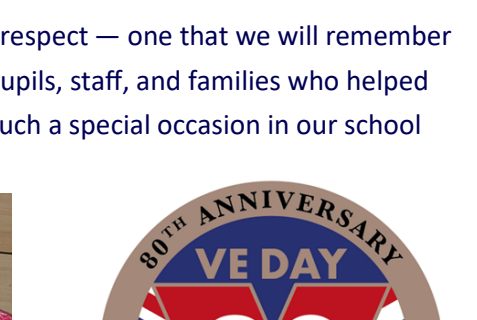
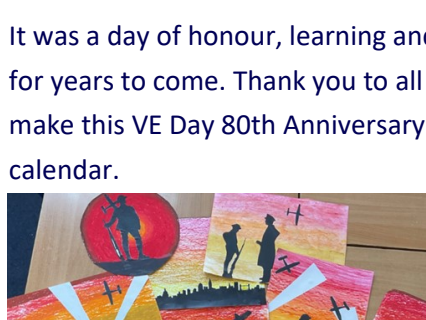
Registration can be made online by visiting the website below. The closing date for registering is 4pm on 27th June 2025. The test will take place on 13th September 2025.

This year marks the 80th anniversary of VE Day, and our school community came together to commemorate this significant moment in history with a day full of learning, reflection and remembrance.

Every year group participated in a range of engaging activities designed to help pupils understand the importance of Victory in Europe Day and the impact of World War II on people's lives. From storytelling and art tasks to singing and letter writing, pupils explored how the war affected families and communities during that time.



A highlight of the day was a special assembly to KS2, led by Mr Goldstraw, who shared a powerful and personal account of how the war had shaped his own family's story. He brought in original uniforms and artefacts from the period, giving pupils the opportunity to see real pieces of history. His visit truly brought the past to life and left a lasting impression on all who attended. We are incredibly grateful to Mr Goldstraw for taking the time to speak to us and for helping to make the day so memorable.

In addition to planned activities, pupils across the school shared personal stories and memorabilia from their own families. Many brought in photographs, medals, letters and other keepsakes from grandparents and great-grandparents who served in the war or lived through the time. These touching contributions sparked meaningful conversations and helped deepen our collective understanding of the sacrifices made by previous generations.

It was a day of honour, learning and respect — one that we will remember for years to come. Thank you to all pupils, staff, and families who helped make this VE Day 80th Anniversary such a special occasion in our school calendar.
