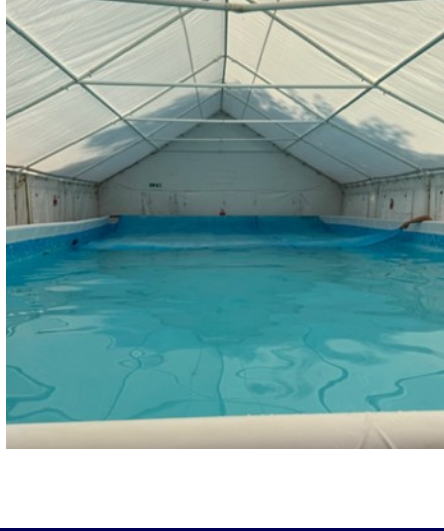

## Grandparents day

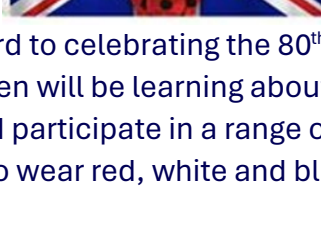
Reception hosted a 'Grandparents Day' recently which was a delightful experience for both our children and their grandparents.

WALT: know how to write instructions

Excellent! GYB

First get your scissors and a roll of paper and a piece of black paper. Then get a glue and cut the black paper around the penguin. Then cut a white oval for the penguin's tummy. Then stick googly eyes on the penguin and a beak. Then get tape and tape the wings on. Finally stick on the feet.

WALT: recall a narrative using punctuation and adjectives
