Message from Mr. Taylor

Dear Parents and Carers,

School Uniform and Jewellery

Can we remind parents that children should attend school wearing the correct uniform. This includes blue jumpers and, in the juniors, a tie. Grey skirts, dresses and jumpers are not part of our school uniform. Trainers are also not part of our school uniform.

We do not permit children to wear jewellery in school, apart from watches, stud earrings and any religious jewellery as discussed with the Head Teacher.

Earrings are always a problem in schools. The preferred option is that children do not wear earrings at all in school.

If you feel that it is essential (as your child has pierced ears) that they continue to wear earrings, then only plain studs are suitable.

Please realise that there have been occasions in schools where injuries have occurred because studs have been worn in P.E. lessons. If earrings cannot be removed by the child, they will need to be taped over by the child. The school cannot take responsibility for any loss or damage to earrings or injury due to earrings.

Punctuality

The School bell goes at 8.50am and this is when your child should be walking into the school building. The register is taken at 8.55am. If your child is entering after this, they will be marked as late. Children begin learning as soon as they arrive, so lateness adds up to missed learning time and can also be embarrassing for children.

Illness

If your child has a stomach or sickness bug, please do not send them into school for 48 hours. This is to protect other children and staff from cross contamination.

Please leave a message on the absence line by 9.30am if your child is going to be absent from school. Please do not send an email to the enquiry email. This inbox is not necessarily monitored each morning and therefore important messages can be missed.

Scooters and Bikes

Children should not ride scooters or bikes on the playground at any time. They should dismount at the school gates and walk scooters and bikes to the designated parking areas where they must be kept locked as school will not take any responsibility for lost or broken equipment.

Medication

Only medication that has been prescribed can be brought into school.

If your child is prescribed medication such as antibiotics, school will only administer this when it needs to be taken 4 times a day and you must notify the school office as a medication form will need to be completed.

If your child has been prescribed an inhaler that needs to be used in school, please inform the school office as there are specific forms that need to be completed.

Allergies

Due to a number of pupils and staff who have nut allergies, children **MUST NOT** bring to school any nuts or nut based products including snacks that contain Nutella
